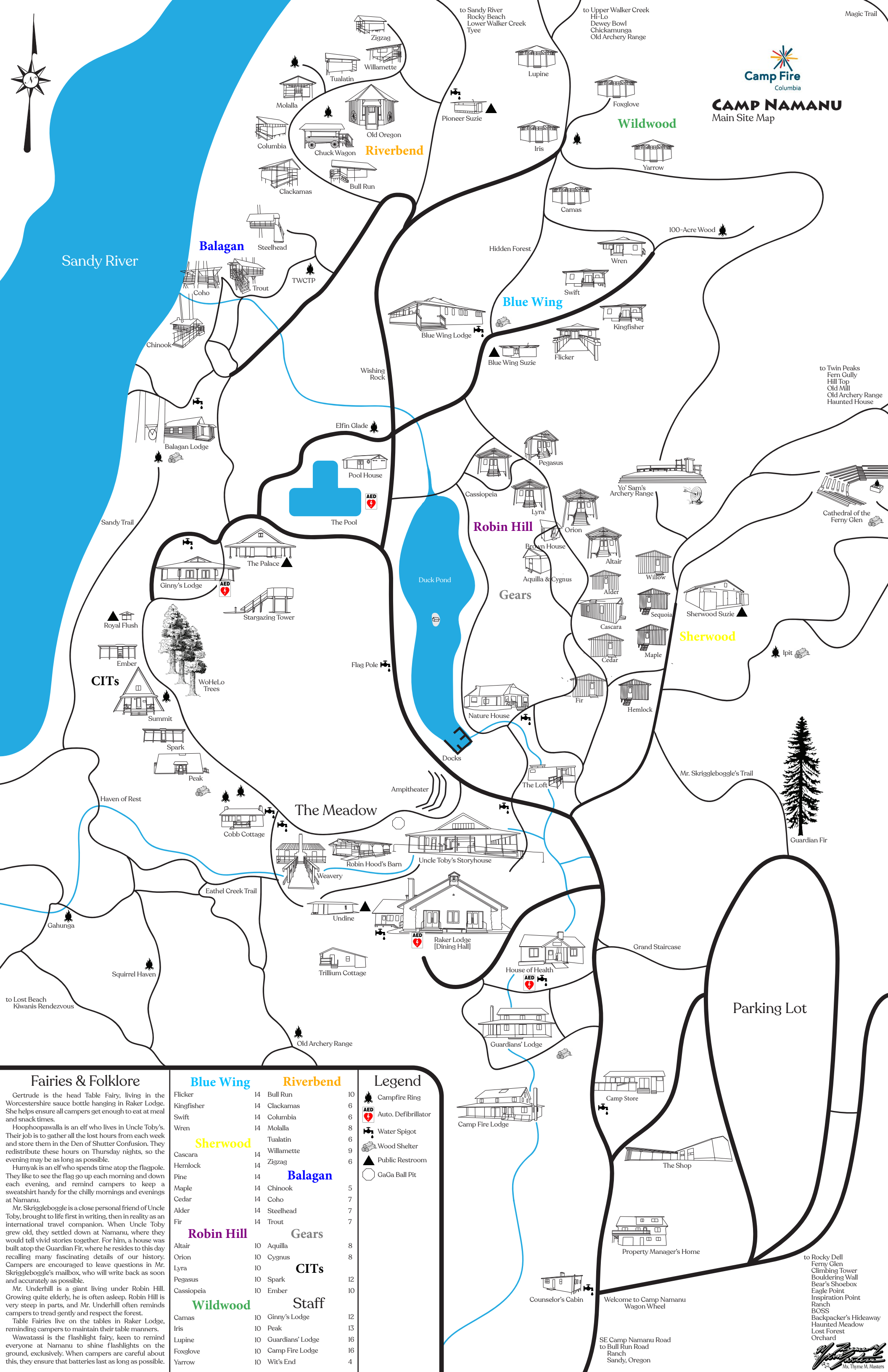

Gertrude is the head Table Fairy, living in the Worcestershire sauce bottle hanging in Raker Lodge. She helps ensure all campers get enough to eat at meal and snack times.

Hoophoopawalla is an elf who lives in Uncle Toby's. Their job is to gather all the lost hours from each week and store them in the Den of Shutter Confusion. They redistribute these hours on Thursday nights, so the evening may be as long as possible.

Humyak is an elf who spends time atop the flagpole. They like to see the flag go up each morning and down each evening, and remind campers to keep a sweatshirt handy for the chilly mornings and evenings at Namanu.

Mr. Skriggleboggle is a close personal friend of Uncle Toby, brought to life first in writing, then in reality as an international travel companion. When Uncle Toby grew old, they settled down at Namanu, where they would tell vivid stories together.
